COMPOSITION

Composition is the cornerstone of any art form. Knowing how to combine elements in an image - what to put in, what to leave out, learning the basic rules of composition and when to use them, when to break them, when to ignore them, and photographing with intention are integral pieces of the compositional process. In this presentation, we'll chat about the Previsualization/Compositional process, and ways to make your images more dynamic.
